### **Team Captain Responsibilities:**

- Make contact with team members prior to the event- introduce yourself, encourage the team to dress the theme!
- Gather your team at your designated starting sponsor's station
- Keep the team cohesive and engaged throughout the event
- Gather coasters collected throughout the rotations (1 from each stop)
- Following food/drink/photobooth stops, regroup and get to the next designated sponsor's station. Have fun but don't lose momentum!

### **The Rules:**

- Each stop will be approximately 5 min for a total of 100 min of rotations
- Each team will rotate CLOCKWISE when you hear Rich Melchior announce "GIDDY UP!" Please pay attention to the rotation sequence since the room setup will be different than past years.
- Entire team must be engaged during the presentation/discussion. At the sponsor's discretion, each team will be given ONE COASTER at the end of the time interval. They will also be using a points system to secretly GRADE each team based on attentiveness and interaction that will be collected at the end of the event.
- Each team will only be allowed to receive ONE coaster per sponsor.
- At the conclusion of all rotations there will be free time to allow teams to increase their coaster and points collection by interacting with NON-VISITED sponsors.
